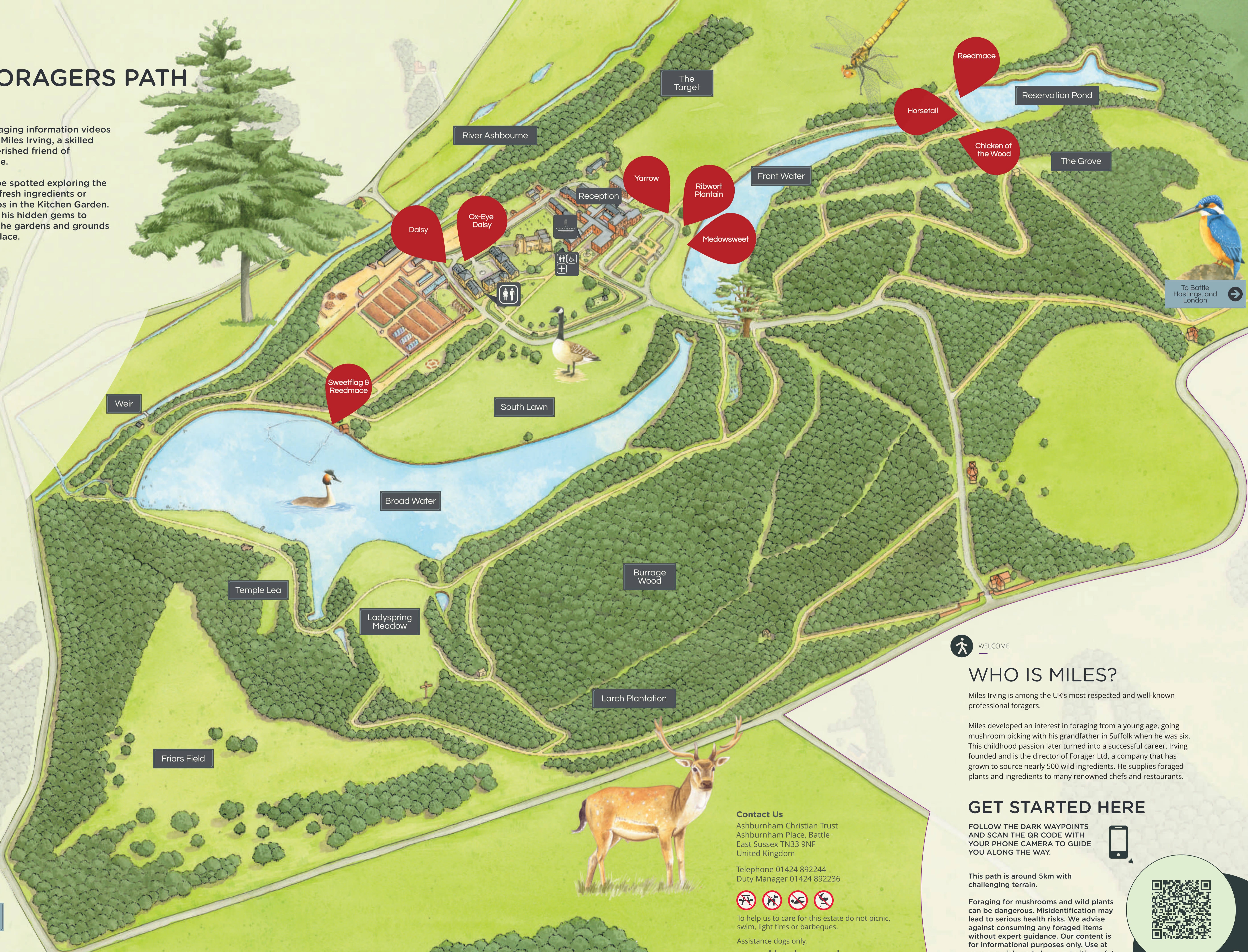


THE FORAGERS PATH
